AUSTRALIAN MASTERS 2020



A successful Australian Masters has been run at Bridgewater over the Australian Day Long weekend. Bridgewater Ski Club once again hosted the event on behalf of Tournament Water Ski Australia where some great scores were concreted amongst the Bridgewater history.

Spectators viewed 60 of the best water skiers from across the country all competing for Gold. The conditions were perfect over the weekend and officials were left doing the paperwork for 5 pending Australian Records.

AUSSIE KIWI CHAMPIONSHIPS LAKE CRICHTON---NZ



Australia was represented in New Zealand at Lake Crichton at the Aussie Kiwi Championships with three teams flying our flag, those being the U14, U17 and U21. A total of 24 skiers and 33 support crew made the journey across the Tasman. Lisa Beare was Team Manager doing an exceptional

job, Ryan Burns was once again Captain with Molly Ferguson Vice Captain both doing an amazing job supporting our skiers both on and off the water.

Our results were outstanding with in excess of 20PBs with 22 of our 24 skiers receiving individual medals and Australia took out Gold in all three divisions including the Overall Trophy.

Some of the more outstanding results were both Erica Hayes and Fletcher Green. At the time of writing Erica having two Australian records approved with one pending and Fletcher having 3 Australian U12 records

Our U14 team took every medal on offer for their division – and everyone of the 8 skiers got an individual medal. Sade Ferguson set a new NZ All Comers jump record beating it by over 3 metres. (this record has stood since 1997). Sade also won the Williams Family trophy for Outstanding performance. Casey Wooderson was awarded the Kyle Eade award for Australia for winning slalom, jump and overall- setting 2 new PBs along the way.

Gaye Moroney stepped up to the role of assistant chief judge, Layne Moroney and Kurtis Beare being the only skiers from either team that judged along with many of our parents.

In summery these Championships were a major success both on and off the water!





The Cory Pickos site of the 2020 Junior World Championships


